## **Attempted Residential Burglary/ Aggravated Assault on an Officer**

Russellville Police Department received several calls of service last night (03/22/2014 between the times of 9:00pm to 11:00pm) in reference to someone attempting to force their way into multiple residences on the west side of town.

While canvassing the area an Officer exited his patrol unit near the location of the last burglary (500 Block of North Inglewood Avenue) in attempt to locate any suspicious activity on foot. He noticed a vehicle which appeared to be suspicious in the area. The Officer attempted to stop the vehicle that was driving toward him while he was walking down the street; the vehicle swerved toward him attempting to hit the Officer. The Officer was not injured during this incident.

Several other patrol Units found the vehicle a couple of blocks away where a short pursuit ensued. The suspect who was identified to be Milek Jamaal Miles (20 years old) was taken to the Russellville Police Department to be interviewed.

Miles was transported later in the night to Pope County Detention Center and placed on a felony hold for Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer, Attempted Residential Burglary, Fleeing in a Vehicle and Reckless Driving.

The investigation is ongoing at this time.
