Commercial Burglary

Russellville Police responded to a Burglary Alarm at 3065 East Main Street (AT&T Store) this morning (01/29/2014) around 1:43 AM.

Officers arrived on scene and noticed a broken window; it appeared that the store had been entered. One Officer noticed a suspicious vehicle (Chevrolet Trailblazer) leaving the area as he was arriving on scene. The Officer attempted to perform a traffic stop on the SUV by turning on his emergency lights and siren, the SUV refused to stop and sped away. The vehicle turned onto Interstate 40 heading Eastbound, the pursuit continued until the SUV wrecked at the 107 mile marker, when the driver attempted to avoid the tire deflation system that was deployed by a Conway County Sheriff's Department.

Both suspects (Calvin Horton 27 years old and Michael Mitchell 26 years old) in the vehicle were arrested and transported to Conway Regional Medical Center by ambulance for their injuries that they sustained in the MVC.

The AT&T store manager reported several items stolen, that were recovered by Officers near the premise of the business and the MVC.

At the time of this release Calvin Horton has been transported to Pope County Detention Center and placed on a Felony Hold for Burglary, Felony Theft of Property, Criminal Mischief in the 2nd Degree, and Felony Fleeing. Michael Mitchell remains in Conway Regional Medical Center.
